- Hand-written applications or applications filled in using an incorrect CN form, with different checksum on paper and electronic versions will be automatically rejected.*
- The evaluation will be carried out in accordance with the evaluation grid from the Guidelines for Applicants (GfA) and it will be based solely on the information provided by the Lead beneficiary in the CN.*
- The CN will be **automatically rejected** without asking for clarification if the partnership is not in line with point ... of the GfA;*
- The lead beneficiaries are obliged to submit the CN along with the **Partnership statements** signed by the authorized persons of all beneficiaries' institutions in the project (point 6 of the CN).*
